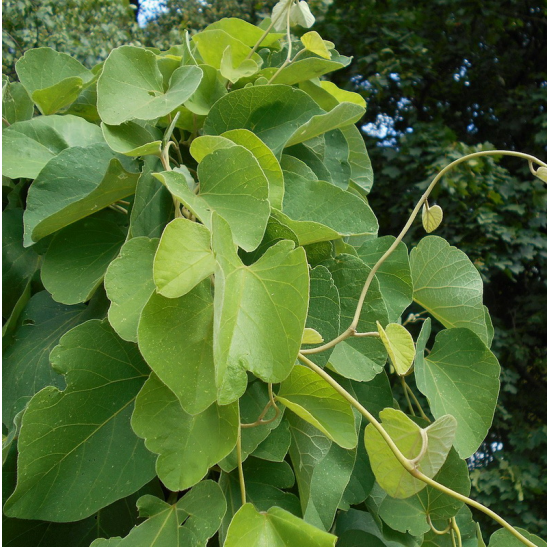

Aristolochiaceae

Plant Specifics

Size:	climbing ft tall by 20+ ft ft wide
Life Span:	Long-lived perennial
Flower Color:	Yellow,purple,green
Habitats:	Stream banks, flood plains, bottomland

Landscaping

Recommended Uses: Primarily used in butterfly gardens but can make a good hanging pot plant or vine on a post or trellice

Light: ☀ Full Sun, ☁ Part Shade

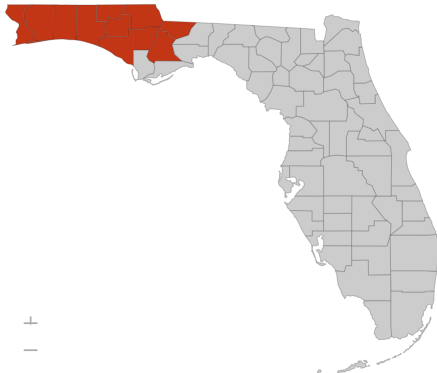
Moisture Tolerance: Usually moist, occasional inundation ----- to Somewhat moist, no flooding

Salt Water Flooding Tolerance: Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.

Salt Spray Tolerance: Low/no tolerance of salty wind or direct salt spray

Soil/Substrate: Loam, Sand
