Water Hyssop, Herb-of-grace Plantaginaceae

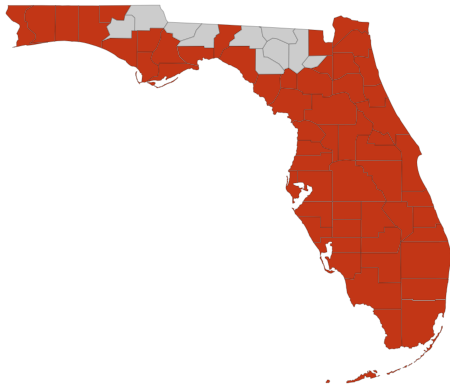
Plant Specifics

- Size: to 6 inches ft tall by extensive mats ft wide
- Life Span: Long-lived perennial
- Flower Color: White,pink
- Phenology: Winter dormant
- Habitats: Lakes edges, stream floodplains, marshes, swamps

Landscaping

- Recommended Uses: Low ground-hugging ground cover in restoration areas, in ditches, and on wetland edges.
- Light: ☀ Full Sun, ☁ Part Shade
- Moisture Tolerance: Aquatic (always flooded) ----- to ----- Usually moist, occasional inundation
- Salt Water Flooding Tolerance: Tolerant of inundation with brackish water
- Salt Spray Tolerance: Some tolerance to salty wind but not direct spray.
- Soil/Substrate: Organic material (muck), Sand
