Asteraceae (Compositae)

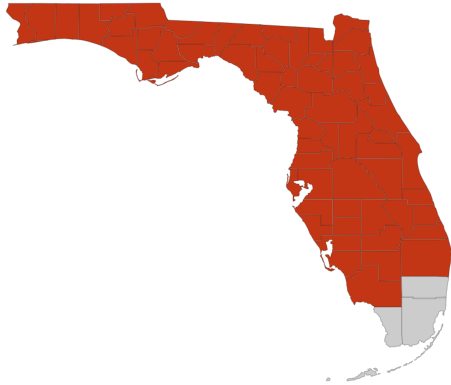
Plant Specifics

- Size: to 3 ft
- Life Span: Long-lived perennial
- Flower Color: Pink, purple
- Phenology: Winter dormant
- Habitats: Hydric to mesic pine flatwoods, cutthroat seeps, bogs.

Landscaping

- Recommended Uses: Wildflower gardens.
- Light: ☀ Full Sun
- Moisture Tolerance: Stays Wet ----- to ----- Not wet but not extremely dry
- Salt Water Flooding Tolerance: Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.
- Salt Spray Tolerance: Low/no tolerance of salty wind or direct salt spray
- Soil/Substrate: Sand
