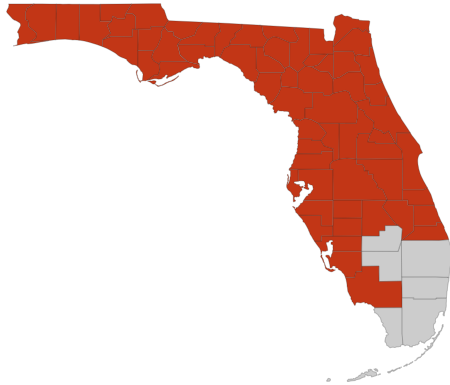

Asteraceae (Compositae)

Plant Specifics

Size:	1-2 ft tall by 1 ft wide
Life Span:	Short-lived perennial
Flower Color:	Yellow
Fruit Color:	Brown,black,NA
Phenology:	Winter dormant
Habitats:	Moist to moderately dry well-drained soils

Recommended Uses:	Use in wildflower gardens. Gradually spread to form small clusters of plants.
Light:	☀ Full Sun, ☁ Part Shade
Moisture Tolerance:	Somewhat moist, no flooding ----- to ----- Not wet but not extremely dry
Salt Water Flooding Tolerance:	Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.
Salt Spray Tolerance:	Low/no tolerance of salty wind or direct salt spray
Soil/Substrate:	Loam, Sand
