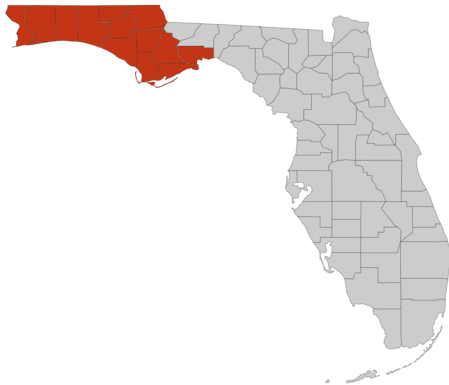
False-rosemary

Lamiaceae (Labiatae)

Plant Specifics

- Size:** 2-3 ft tall by 2-3 ft wide
- Life Span:** Long-lived perennial
- Flower Color:** Lavender
- Phenology:** Evergreen. Primarily blooms in spring. Long-lived (Nelson 2003) if grown in appropriately open, dry sandy sites.
- Habitats:** Scrub, sandhill.

- Recommended Uses:** Gray-green, fine foliage, border plant or individual specimens in a wildflower garden
- Light:** ☀ Full Sun
- Moisture Tolerance:** Not wet but not extremely dry ----- to ----- Very long very dry periods
- Salt Water Flooding Tolerance:** Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.
- Salt Spray Tolerance:** Some tolerance to salty wind but not direct spray.
- Soil/Substrate:** Sand
