Plant Specifics

Size: 2-3 (4) ft tall by 1-3 ft wide

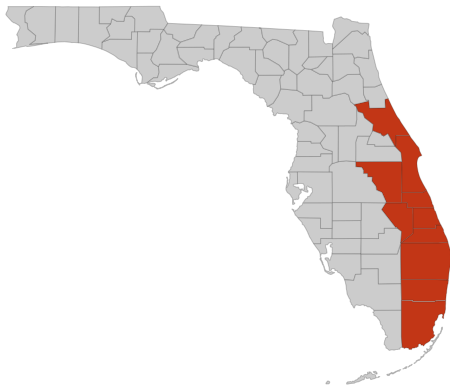
Life Span: Long-lived perennial

Flower Color: Purple, lavender

Phenology: Evergreen. Long blooming and fruiting period generally in warmer months. Long-lived (Nelson 2003) in good habitat conditions including soil, drainage, and light.

Habitats: Scrub, coastal strand. In disturbed areas.
