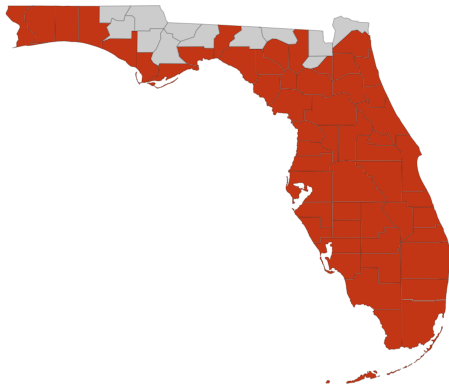
## Leavenworth's Tickseed

### Asteraceae (Compositae)

#### Plant Specifics

- Size:** 1.5 to 3.0 ft tall by .5 to 1.5 ft wide
- Life Span:** Annual to short-lived perennial
- Flower Color:** Yellow
- Phenology:** Annual. Flowers all year.
- Habitats:** Moist to wet flatwoods, marl prairies, sandhill, scrub, and disturbed areas. Common on moist, open roadsides.

#### Landscaping

- Recommended Uses:** Cultivated flower beds, wildflower gardens, meadows, and butterfly gardens.
- Light:** ☀ Full Sun
- Moisture Tolerance:** Somewhat moist, no flooding ----- to ----- Not wet but not extremely dry
- Salt Water Flooding Tolerance:** Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.
- Salt Spray Tolerance:** Low/no tolerance of salty wind or direct salt spray
- Soil/Substrate:** Clay, Loam, Sand
