Plant Specifics

- Size: About 0.5 ft
- Life Span: Annual to short-lived perennial
- Flower Color: Lavender
- Habitats: Forested areas around wetlands

- Recommended Uses: Wildflower garden, groundcover

- Light: ☀ Full Sun, ☁ Part Shade

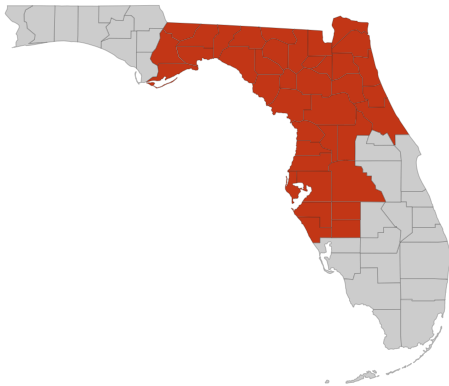
- Moisture Tolerance: Somewhat moist, no flooding ----- to -----

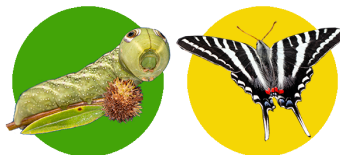
