Equisetaceae

Plant Specifics

- Size: 2-4 ft tall by 0.1 ft wide
- Life Span: Long-lived perennial
- Phenology: Evergreen
- Habitats: Sandy soils in river floodplains, lake edges, ditch sloughs.

Landscaping

Recommended Uses: Water gardens, edges of retention ponds

Light: ☀ Full Sun, ☁ Part Shade

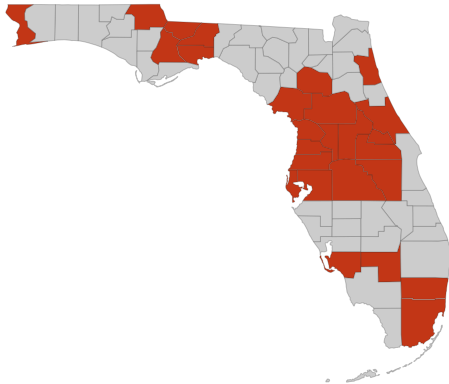
Moisture Tolerance: Aquatic ----- to ----- Usually moist, occasional inundation

Salt Water Flooding Tolerance: Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.

Salt Spray Tolerance: Low/no tolerance of salty wind or direct salt spray

Soil/Substrate: Pond, lake, or stream bottom, Loam
