## Pineland Heliotrope

### *Boraginaceae*

Also known as *Heliotropium polyphyllum*

### Plant Specifics

Size: 0.5 to 1 ft

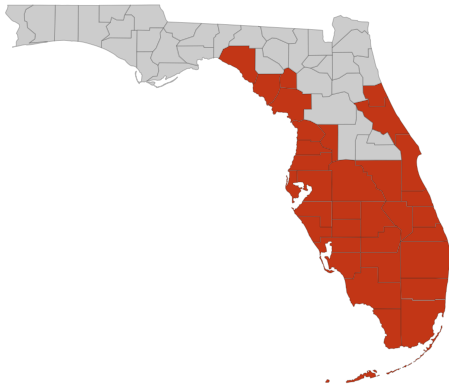
Life Span: Short-lived perennial

Flower Color: White, yellow

Phenology: Winter dormant

Habitats: Flatwoods near edges of open wetlands; roadsides through such places. Coastal thickets.

Recommended Uses: Sprawling. Best used as a wildflower.

Light: ☀ Full Sun, ☁ Part Shade

Moisture Tolerance: Usually moist, occasional inundation ----- to Short very dry periods

Salt Water Flooding Tolerance: Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.

Salt Spray Tolerance: Some tolerance to salty wind but not direct spray.

Soil/Substrate: Sand
