Asteraceae (Compositae)

Plant Specifics

- Size: very low basal rosette with a 2-2.5 ft flower stalk
- Life Span: Annual
- Flower Color: Brown
- Fruit Color: Brown
- Habitats: Flatwoods. Moist to dry roadsides.

Light: ☀ Full Sun

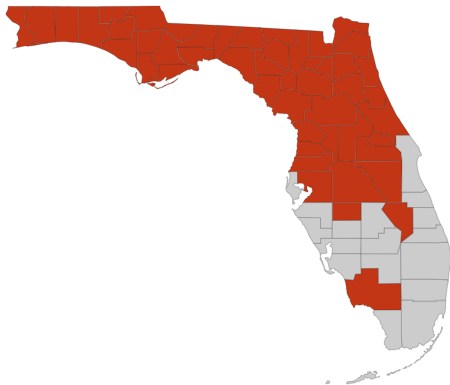
Moisture Tolerance: Usually moist, occasional inundation ----- to -

Salt Water Flooding Tolerance: Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.
