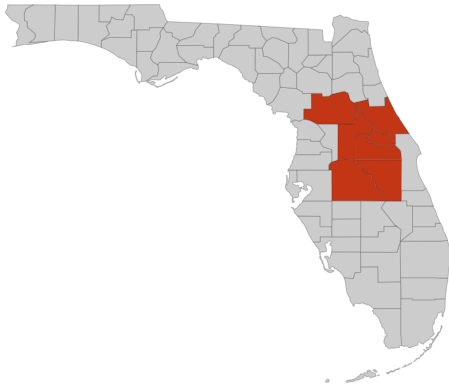

Yellow Star Anise

Plant Specifics

- Size:** 15-20 ft tall by 10-15 ft wide
- Life Span:** Long-lived perennial
- Flower Color:** Yellow
- Fruit Color:** Brown
- Phenology:** Evergreen. Blooms in spring. Fruits ripen late summer-fall.
- Habitats:** Bottomland forest, hydric hammock, baygall, bay of spring run and seepage streams, wet upland mixed forest. Can be seen near several of the spring runs in Ocala National Forest.

- Recommended Uses:** Hedges, specimen shrubs, screens, foundational plantings.
- Light:** ☁ Shade
- Moisture Tolerance:** Stays Wet ----- to ----- Not wet but not extremely dry
- Salt Water Flooding Tolerance:** Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.
- Salt Spray Tolerance:** Low/no tolerance of salty wind or direct salt spray
- Soil/Substrate:** Loam, Sand
