### *Convolvulaceae*

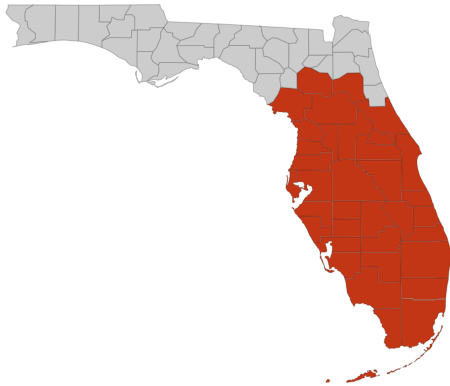
#### Plant Specifics

Size:	to 40 ft
Life Span:	Long-lived perennial
Flower Color:	White
Phenology:	Blooms summer into early fall
Habitats:	Disturbed wetland and lake edges, mangrove fringes.

#### Landscaping

Recommended Uses:	Recommended only for use where it can be controlled such as on a trellis or in areas where expansive growth is appropriate.
Light:	☀ Full Sun, ☁ Part Shade
Moisture Tolerance:	Usually moist, occasional inundation ----- to Not wet but not extremely dry
Salt Water Flooding Tolerance:	Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.
Salt Spray Tolerance:	Low/no tolerance of salty wind or direct salt spray
Soil/Substrate:	Loam, Sand
