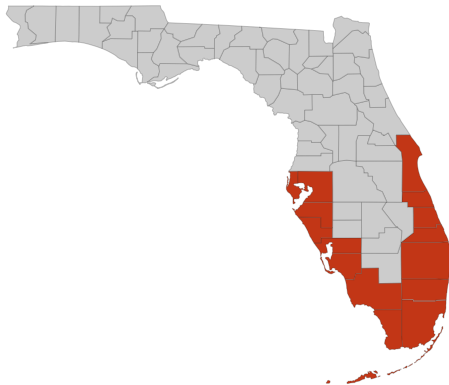
## Wild Lantana, Wild Sage

### Verbenaceae

### Plant Specifics

- Size: 4-6 (10) ft tall by 2-3 ft wide
- Life Span: Long-lived perennial
- Flower Color: White
- Fruit Color: Purple
- Phenology: Evergreen. Blooms and fruits year round.
- Habitats: Coastal dunes. Disturbed areas in tropical hammocks (needs light) and pine rocklands.

### Landscaping

- Recommended Uses: Cover plant, hedge plant, screen.
- Light: ☀ Full Sun, ☁ Part Shade
- Moisture Tolerance: Not wet but not extremely dry ----- to ----- Ver long very dry periods
- Salt Water Flooding Tolerance: Tolerant of occasional/brief inundation such : can occur in storm surges.
- Salt Spray Tolerance: Some tolerance to salty wind but not direct s spray.
- Soil/Substrate: Sand
