

## Spicebush Lauraceae Plant Specifics

Size:	to 10 ft
Life Span:	Long-lived perennial
Flower Color:	Yellow
Fruit Color:	Red
Phenology:	Deciduous
Habitats:	Bluffs, floodplains, calcareous hammocks. Rare.

### Landscaping

Recommended Uses:	Naturalistic settings and informal wet hamme settings.
Light:	Shade
Moisture Tolerance:	Usually moist, occasional inundation to - Somewhat moist, no flooding
Salt Water Flooding Tolerance:	Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.
Salt Spray Tolerance:	Low/no tolerance of salty wind or direct salt spray
Soil/Substrate:	Organic material (muck), Sand
