#### **Plant Specifics**

Size:	5-20 ft tall by 3-15 ft wide with the potential to fo small clones.
Life Span:	Long-lived perennial
Flower Color:	White
Fruit Color:	Orange
Phenology:	Evergreen. Flowers sporadically throughout the year with best bloom in spring and early summe
Habitats:	Tropical rockland hammock, coastal hammock.

### Landscaping

Recommended Uses:	Specimen plant. Roadsides, parking lot edge and medians. Smaller forms can make good foundation screens.
Light:	🏟 Full Sun, 🌤 Part Shade
Moisture Tolerance:	Somewhat moist, no flooding to Very long very dry periods
Salt Water Flooding Tolerance:	Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.
Salt Spray Tolerance:	Some tolerance to salty wind but not direct s spray.
Soil/Substrate:	Humus (organic, upland), Lime rock, Sand
