Size:	0.5 - 0.75 ft tall by 1-2 ft wide
Life Span:	Long-lived perennial
Flower Color:	Green
Phenology:	Evergreen
Habitats:	Swamps (epiphytic on trees/logs).

Landscaping

Recommended Uses:	Groundcover.
Light:	Shade
Moisture Tolerance:	Usually moist, occasional inundation to - Somewhat moist, no flooding
Salt Water Flooding Tolerance:	Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.
Salt Spray Tolerance:	Low/no tolerance of salty wind or direct salt spray
Soil/Substrate:	Epiphytic (growing on trees), Humus (organi upland)

Wildlife

The floral morphology of *Peperomia* species suggests wind- and/or insect pollination, but not much is known.
