Lamiaceae (Labiatae)

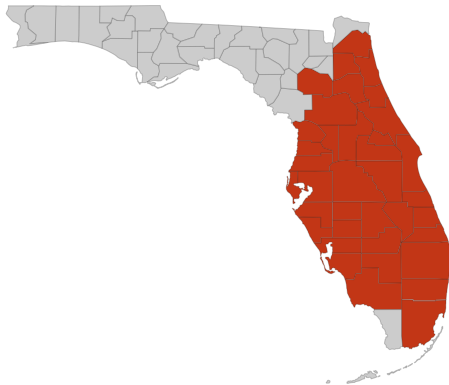
Plant Specifics

Size:	1-2 ft tall by 1 ft wide
Life Span:	Long-lived perennial
Flower Color:	Lavender
Phenology:	Evergreen. Blooms all year but most abundantly spring.
Habitats:	Scrubby flatwoods, scrub, dry flatwoods, dry prairie, sandhill, ruderal.

Landscaping

Recommended Uses:	Wildflower garden, groundcover.
Light:	☀ Full Sun
Moisture Tolerance:	Not wet but not extremely dry ----- to ----- Somewhat long very dry periods
Salt Water Flooding Tolerance:	Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.
Salt Spray Tolerance:	Low/no tolerance of salty wind or direct salt spray
Soil/Substrate:	Sand
