## Bahama Wild-coffee

### *Rubiaceae*

#### Plant Specifics

- Size: 3-4 ft tall by 3-4 ft wide
- Life Span: Long-lived perennial
- Flower Color: White
- Phenology: Evergreen. Blooms and fruits all year except during cold or dry spells.
- Habitats: Tropical hammocks, pine flatwoods.

#### Landscaping

Recommended Uses: Specimen or hedge plant.

Uses:

Light: ☀️ Part Shade

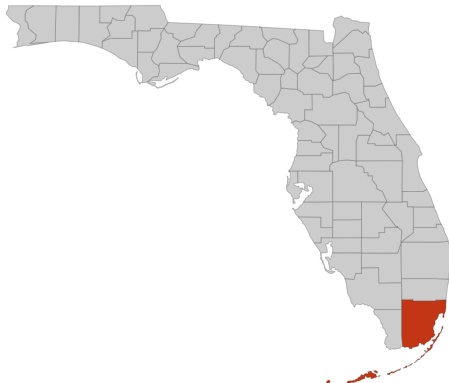
Moisture Tolerance: Usually moist, occasional inundation ----- to Not wet but not extremely dry

Salt Water Flooding Tolerance: Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.

Salt Spray Tolerance: Some tolerance to salty wind but not direct spray.

Soil/Substrate: Lime rock, Sand
