### *Rubiaceae*

Also known as *Psychotria sulzneri*

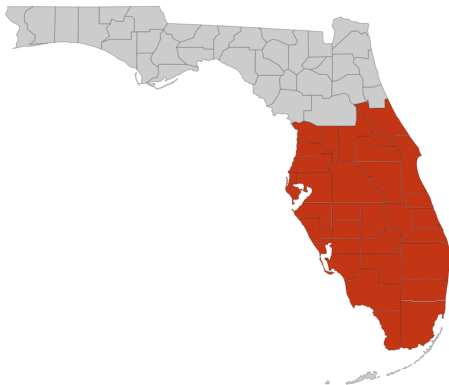
### Plant Specifics

Size:	3-4 ft
Life Span:	Short-lived perennial
Flower Color:	White
Fruit Color:	Red
Phenology:	Evergreen. Blooms and fruits year round except during cold or drought.
Habitats:	Dry mesic to mesic and hydric hammock, secon bottom, shell mounds, floodplains.

### Landscaping

Recommended Uses:	Tallish groundcover in mesic (moist) areas. Can be planted in groupings in shady areas. Despite the name, the leaves are pretty, almost silky velvety in appearance.
Light:	☀️ Part Shade, ☁️ Shade
Moisture Tolerance:	Usually moist, occasional inundation ----- to -
Salt Water Flooding Tolerance:	Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.

**Salt Spray Tolerance:**

Moderate. Tolerant of salty wind and may get some salt spray. Exposure to salt spray would be uncommon (major storms).
