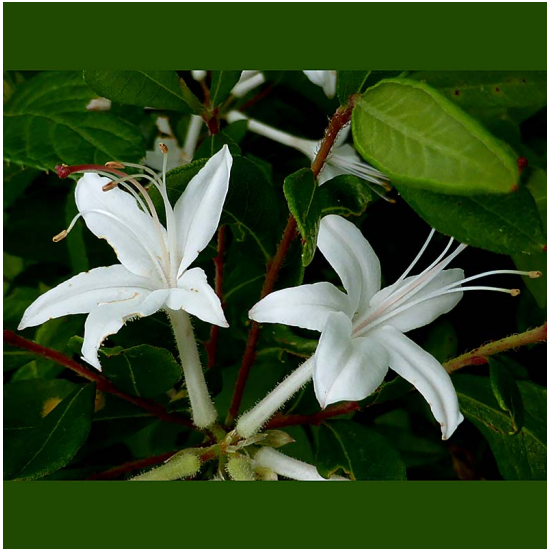

Ericaceae

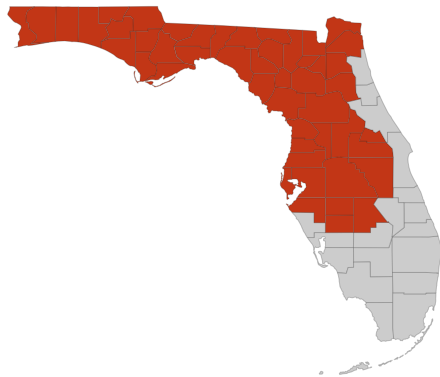
Plant Specifics

Size:	5-15 ft tall by to 12 ft wide
Life Span:	Long-lived perennial
Flower Color:	White, pink
Phenology:	Deciduous
Habitats:	Moist-wet sites. Seep swamps, pineland-wetland ecotones, edges of bay swamps, moist woods.

Landscaping

Recommended Uses:	Specimen plant for moist shady areas.
Light:	☀️ Part Shade, ☁️ Shade
Moisture Tolerance:	Stays Wet ----- to ----- Somewhat moist, no flooding
Salt Water Flooding Tolerance:	Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.
Salt Spray Tolerance:	Low/no tolerance of salty wind or direct salt spray
Soil/Substrate:	Organic material (muck), Sand
