## Yellow Necklacepod

*Fabaceae (Leguminosae)*

### Plant Specifics

Size: 6-12 ft

Life Span: Long-lived perennial

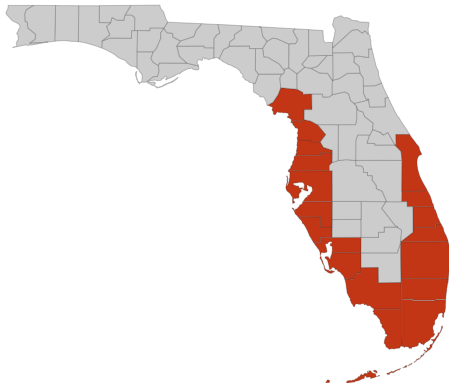
Flower Color: Yellow

Fruit Color: Brown

Phenology: Evergreen. Blooms all year except in cold or drought periods. Moderately long-lived (Nelson 2003).

Habitats: Shell mound, maritime hammock, beach dune, coastal strand, inland borders of marine tidal swamp, marine tidal marsh (salt marsh).

### Landscaping

Recommended Uses: Use as an accent tree or shrub. It has a long blooming period, tolerates poor soils, and is easy to grow.

Light: ☀ Full Sun

Moisture Tolerance: Usually moist, occasional inundation ----- to Very long very dry periods

Salt Water Flooding Tolerance: Tolerant of occasional/brief inundation such as can occur in storm surges.

Salt Spray Tolerance: High. Can tolerate significant and ongoing amounts of salty wind and salt spray without injury.

Soil/Substrate: Sand
