### *Poaceae (Gramineae)*

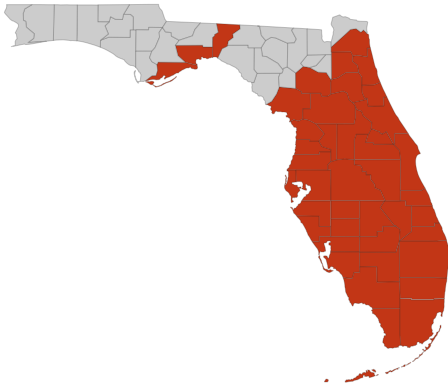
#### Plant Specifics

- Size:** 3-4 (6) ft
- Life Span:** Long-lived perennial
- Phenology:** Evergreen
- Habitats:** Wet prairie, edges of marshes, but mostly inland rarely coastal.

#### Landscaping

- Recommended Uses:** Large clump-forming grass with uses as tall groundcover, specimen plant, or border plant. Nice along edges of ponds and water features.
- Light:** ☀ Full Sun
- Moisture Tolerance:** Usually moist, occasional inundation ----- to Not wet but not extremely dry
- Salt Water Flooding Tolerance:** Not salt tolerant of inundation by salty or brackish water.
- Salt Spray Tolerance:** Moderate. Tolerant of salty wind and may get some salt spray. Exposure to salt spray would be uncommon (major storms).
- Soil/Substrate:** Sand
